



Killarney Senior's Bus Excursion Bala Ontario

The Municipality is organizing a day bus excursion to the Bala Cranberry Festival for the festival's Seniors Day on Friday October 18th. The Senior Bus Excursion is contingent on receiving funding from the Ministry of Seniors and Accessibility Senior Community Grant, and on the number of seniors who register to participate.



The charter bus accommodates 56 people total. 6 volunteers are required for the maximum registration of 50 seniors. It is preferred that volunteers also be seniors, but it is not mandatory.

The funding will cover the cost of the bus, entrance fees to the Bala Cranberry Festival and Johnston's Cranberry Marsh and an organized lunch. Participants will be responsible for any other purchases. The bus will pick up residents in Ward 1 at the Veteran's Memorial Hall at 7:00 am and residents of Ward 2 at a location on Hartley Bay Road (to be determined) at approximately 8:15 am. On the return home there will be a stop at the French River Trading Post for one half hour before returning residents to their pick up locations. Return time is approximately 4:30 pm for Ward 2 and 5:45 pm for Ward 1.

Get the gang together and register for a day of Fun and Insight with a great opportunity to get to know your neighbours.

Registrations must be in no later than Wednesday October 2nd at 11:00 am.
