

# **THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KILLARNEY**

## **BY-LAW NO. 2017-20**

### **BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2012-26 FOR THE LICENCING AND REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION OF DOGS AND FOR THE CONTROL AND KEEPING OF DOGS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KILLARNEY**

**WHEREAS** By-Law #2012-26 of the Municipality of Killarney has been enacted and passed on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012 to authorize the licencing, the control and the keeping of dogs within the Municipality of Killarney;

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it desirable to amended the definition section of By-Law No. 2012-26 to include the Dog Owners' Liability Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. D. 16 (DOLA);

**AND WHEREAS** all other provisions of By-Law No. 2012-26 and 2013-04 remain in full force and effect;

#### ***NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KILLARNEY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:***

1. That the definitions section of By-law 2012-26 be amended to state the following under 4.1 "Animal Control Officer" includes the person or association who has entered into a contract with the Municipality to control dogs and to operate a dog pound and any servants of such person or association and all servants thereof are hereby appointed Municipal Law Enforcement Officers pursuant to Bill 74 and the Provincial Offences Act, who shall be Peace Officers for the purpose of enforcing the animal control and dog licensing By-law as well as the Dog Owners' Liability Act (DOLA) and related legal process serving;
2. Further that the definitions section of By-law 2012-26 will further be amended with the addition of 4.10 which states the following:

4.10 "DOLA" means the Dog Owners' Liability Act
3. Further that this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing.
