- due to the extensive number of unknown issues associated with this proposed connection (such as interference with existing underground services, crossing private property, underground hydro services, the substantial work and expense involved to open up the road allowance due to the topography of the area which would require blasting and excavation where the municipal roadway would have to be established etc. due to bedrock outcropings); and
- possible future issues with freezing, line breaks; and
- understanding that all water expenses relating to this connection which are the responsibility of the municipality, current and future repairs/maintenance would be borne 100% by the water users exclusively as water expenses cannot be spread over the entire tax base; and
- whereby the requests to connect to municipal infrastructure were denied by previous Councils; and
- as the property owners have the option of obtaining water from a well or from the bay;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT it is hereby the decision of Council that this request to connect to the municipal water system is hereby denied and this will be the final time the Municipality will entertain any future requests for this property to be connected to the municipal water system as there are simply too many variables.
