WHEREAS the Government of Ontario has introduced Bill 5: Protecting Ontario by Unleashing Our Economy Act, 2025, which proposes substantial changes to environmental planning legislation, including the repeal of the Endangered Species Act and the creation of "Special Economic Zones" that may override local planning authority; and

**WHEREAS** the Municipality of Killarney supports increasing housing supply and economic growth, but believes this must be achieved without undermining environmental protections or compromising the integrity of municipal planning processes; and

**WHEREAS** Bill 5, as proposed, risks weakening safeguards for Ontario's natural heritage and reducing the role of municipalities in managing growth in a responsible and locally informed manner;

**WHEREAS** the Council for the Municipality of Killarney acknowledges the letter received from the Sportsman's Inn Resort and Marina dated May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025 requesting an exemption to the noise by-law until 1:00 AM on August 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 as well as a temporary patio extension to hold their 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Killarney Music Festival;

**AND WHEREAS** the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) no longer accept applications for temporary patios for licensees located in municipalities, therefore liquor sales licensees who want to operate a temporary patio need to apply to the municipality for approval;

**AND WHEREAS** if approval from the municipality is granted, the licensee is required to notify AGCO by making a submission before selling or serving liquor on the proposed temporary patio. The tent and cordoned area will extend approximately 3 meters into the parking area from the pavers (licensed areas) for a span of about 30 meters (see attached diagram);

**AND WHEREAS** temporary patios may only operate for a maximum of eight months per calendar year;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Municipality of Killarney hereby gives approval to the Sportsman's Inn Resort and Marina an exemption to the noise by-law until 1:00 AM on August 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 as well as a temporary patio liquor license extension provided they adhere to all existing AGCO requirements for establishments who are liquor sale licensees;
