TAKE NOTICE that a Vacancy exists on the Town of Killarney Council for one (1) Councillor -Ward 1 position. Council has determined to fill this vacancy by appointment.

This is being done in order to properly conduct the day to day operations of the municipality in a timely, responsible manner.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be qualified as defined in the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25. Applicants should possess good communication skills, both oral and written. As well as the ability to demonstrate interpersonal skills in open forum settings such as council meetings, budget meetings, personnel meetings, etc.

Process:

Eligible Ward 1 and Ward 2 applicants are asked to submit a written Council Vacancy Application by completing the attached application form and return “in person” to the attention of the Clerk within the specified timeframe noted on this posting. Applicants are requested to state their qualifications, previous municipal experience and any other skills they can bring to Council.

The Council Vacancy Applications will be addressed by the current council members. From the applications received, a decision will be reached by a vote of Council.

This position will be a valid position in the council structure from the date of appointment and will conclude on November 14, 2026.

Ward 1 & Ward 2 Candidates for Council – Do you Qualify?

For council where the provisions of the *Municipal Act* applies, a person is qualified to hold office who is:

- Entitled to be an elector in the local municipality under Section 17 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*;
- Not disqualified for violations of financial requirements or violations of requirements for filing financial information;
- Not disqualified by this or any Act from holding the office;
- Not disqualified under provisions as outlined in sections 90 (2) and 91 (1) of the *Municipal Elections Act*.

Ward 1 & Ward 2 Candidates – Eligibility Requirement

- Is a Canadian citizen,
- Is at least 18 years old, and
- Resides in the local municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land in the local municipality, or the spouse of such a person; and
- Is not prohibited from voting as noted below or otherwise, by law.

Ineligible Individuals

The following are not eligible to hold office as a member of a Council:

1. As per the Municipal Elections Act:
 - i. An employee of the municipality;

- ii. A person who is not an employee of the municipality but who is the Clerk, Treasurer, Integrity Commissioner, Auditor General, Ombudsman or Registrar or Meeting Investigator;
 - iii. A person who is not an employee of the municipality but who holds any administrative position of the municipality.
2. A judge of any court.
 3. A member of the Assembly as provided in the *Legislative Assembly Act* or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada.
 4. Except in accordance with Part V of the *Public Service of Ontario Act*, 2006 a public servant within the meaning of that Act. 2001, c. 25, s. 258 (1); 2006, c. 32, Sch. A, s. 110; 2006, c. 35, Sch. C, s. 86.

Written Council Vacancy Applications may only be filed with the Clerk or Designate "in person" only along with their proper identification.
The information **cannot** be faxed or emailed.
