



CALL FOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Sudbury East (Nipissing West) O.P.P Detachment Board

The Municipalities within Sudbury East, which includes French River, Killarney, Markstay-Warren, St. Charles, Atikameksheng Anishnawbek First Nation (Whitefish Lake), are seeking applications to form the Sudbury East (Nipissing West) O.P.P Detachment Board as required under the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019.

We are seeking **two community representatives** within the Nipissing Detachment area to form a 7-member board. The other four representatives will be Council appointees (one Council member from each municipality), and one representative will be a Provincial appointee.

The members of the Sudbury East (Nipissing West) O.P.P Detachment Board will be responsible for completing mandatory board training, oversight of the O.P.P. Detachment Commander's local action plan, presenting an annual report to each Council, preparing rules and procedures, creating by-laws/local policies, board policies, and preparing board estimates/budget to Councils for board operations.

The following are ineligible from being members of the Board:

- A judge or justice of the peace.
- A member of a police service, a special constable, or a First Nation officer.
- Any person who practices criminal law as a defence counsel or prosecutor.
- Any person employed by one of the five municipalities policed by the Sudbury East (Nipissing West) O.P.P Detachment Board
- A director, officer, or employee of a prescribed policing provider.
- A former member (retired or otherwise) of a police service who served in the Policing Service(s) of the Board O.P.P. Detachment area.

All interested applicants are encouraged to submit a letter of interest outlining their competencies to the email below by **September 30, 2024, at 5 pm.**
