Mayor Rook called the meeting to order at 7:10 P.M.

#### Public Input Session

Chas Anselmo, KPMG consultant presented the draft Shared Services Proposal report to Council, staff and the public. The study was done for all four municipalities: Killarney, Markstay-Warren, French River and St. Charles. He summarized the services that were recommended to be shared and those that were not, with each one having a short description of the service and the rationale behind the recommendation.

Some of the services mentioned were Group Purchasing, Building Services & By-Law Enforcement, Regional Training, Asset Management Plan, Regional Equipment Maintenance, Regional Economic Development, Fire Services, Senior Administration, Recreation Facilities, Water & Wastewater Services, Solid Waste Management, Library Services and Administrative Functions.

The recommendations were based all or in part on best practices, geographic size as a challenge, local interests, community sensitive services, cost savings or increases and gaps in services.

Mr. Anselmo noted that this Shared Services Proposal Report was not about winners or losers. The concept of financial impact may not be exclusive to cost savings. It was also stated that this is not the first step towards another round of amalgamation.

After the draft report was presented by Mr. Anselmo, the floor was opened up for public input for those in attendance. There were questions relating to timing of the final document, the process of entering into agreements with the other three municipalities etc.

Once all of the questions were addressed by Mr. Anselmo, the Mayor thanked him for his proposal and presentation and the meeting was adjourned.
