



# WORKSHOP

The Municipality is looking for residents interested in Killarney's Culture, Heritage and History to participate in a 2 hour workshop being facilitated by **Know History**. The purpose of the workshop is to gather information so that **Know History** can identify and recommend potential cultural and heritage projects for the Municipality of Killarney and to encourage community volunteers.



The workshop will take place at the end of September or early October.

Participants will explore some of the community's culture, heritage and history, discuss resources (such as staff, volunteers, budgets, etc.) and timeframes for these projects. Participants will be provided a list of questions prior to the workshop to reflect on and prepare answers to be shared during the workshop. Questions may include for example:

- What are Killarney's cultural and heritage goals? (ie: resident interaction)
- What are themes in Killarney's history? (ie: logging, fishing)
- What assets support these themes?(ie: museum, lighthouse)

This is a wonderful opportunity to further develop projects for the Killarney 200 Celebration; to look at new projects which will connect the community to the Culture and Heritage of the area and which may contribute economically by leveraging valuable assets in the Municipality.
