**WHEREAS** the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) has advised the Ministry of Energy (MOE) that the proposed TC Energy Pumped Storage Project on Georgian Bay should not proceed, citing concerns that the project would represent an unfavourable financial arrangement for the Province of Ontario; and

**WHEREAS** the proposed TC Energy Pumped Storage Project on Georgian Bay could cause irreparable harm to the environment and could have significant negative impacts on the local animal, plant, fish, and human populations; and

**WHEREAS** the Project could irreversibly alter and damage the unique ecological, cultural, and historical features of the area, putting at risk the important tourist industry, sport and commercial fishing that relies on these natural benefits; and

**WHEREAS** the Department of National Defense (DND) have failed to adequately remediate the environmental impacts of the military base over the years making it a brownfield site, meaning that the area is already polluted and that the proposed project would exacerbate the situation.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council for the Municipality of Killarney opposes the TC Energy Pumped Storage Project on Georgian Bay and urges DND to immediately implement measures to remediate the military base to ensure that the area is fit for human and animal habitation; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the MOE cease their support of the Project, accept the IESO recommendations that the Project should not be approved, and therefore avoid placing an unnecessary financial burden on Ontario taxpayers; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that this resolution be forwarded to all those noted in the resolution of the Township of Georgian Bay.

**AND FURTHER THAT** all plumbing connections between the buildings shall comply with the requirements of the Ontario Building Code Act and be approved by the Chief Building Official, and shall be installed by a licensed plumber, with final specifications provided to the Municipality;

**AND FURTHER THAT** as the secondary dwelling constitutes a separate service connection, it shall be subject to an additional annual water and sewer maintenance fee in addition to that charged for the main residence;

**AND FURTHER THAT** the water supply required by fixtures in both buildings may affect the available water pressure if multiple fixtures are used simultaneously, and any issues related to reduced water pressure shall remain the responsibility of the property owner and not the Municipality;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** once OCWA, Pinchin Ltd., the Public Works Department, and the Chief Building Official have reviewed and approved the proposed connection plan, Council authorizes the project to proceed, provided all of the above conditions have been satisfied.

**WHEREAS** Council passed Resolution No. 25-410 on December 10, 2025 regarding the request from the Killarney Bay Inn to connect a seasonal staff housing trailer to the main water and sewer connections servicing the main building located at 2000 Noble Street;

**AND WHEREAS** the proposed plumbing design required approval from the Municipality’s consultant, Pinchin Ltd., and the Municipality’s operating authority, the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA);

**AND WHEREAS** Pinchin Ltd. and OCWA have indicated that the water and sewer lines must be properly supported in order for approval to be granted;

**AND WHEREAS** the Chief Building Official has reviewed the proposal and approves of the water and sewer connection into the main building and will ensure that the water and sewer lines are properly supported, inspected, and installed in compliance with the requirements of the Ontario Building Code, and that the plumbing work will be completed by a licensed plumber with a copy of the final specifications provided to the Municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the Chief Building Official has recommended that a separate shut-off valve and one backflow prevention device be installed to protect the municipal water system;

**AND WHEREAS** the seasonal housing trailer is considered a separate service connection with its own shut-off valve and will be charged additional annual water and sewer maintenance fees based on the fixtures located within the structure;

**AND WHEREAS** the supply of water required by fixtures in both buildings may affect the water available if multiple fixtures are used at the same time, and any issues related to low water pressure shall remain the responsibility of the property owner and not the Municipality;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council for the Municipality of Killarney hereby authorizes the water and sewer connections to proceed, provided that all of the above conditions have been or will be satisfied, and that representatives from OCWA and the Public Works Department be present to observe the connection during installation.
