AND FURTHER THAT all plumbing connections shall comply with the requirements of the Ontario Building Code Act and be approved by the Chief Building Official, and shall be installed by a licensed plumber, with final specifications provided to the Municipality;

AND FURTHER THAT as the secondary dwelling constitutes a separate service connection, it shall be subject to an additional annual water and sewer maintenance fee in addition to that charged for the main residence;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT once OCWA, Pinchin Ltd., the Public Works Department, and the Chief Building Official have reviewed and approved the proposed connection plan, Council authorizes the project to proceed, provided all of the above conditions have been satisfied.
